ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Traditional Student, Non-Traditional Student, Trade School Student, or Graduate Student
- Currently attending a post secondary, accredited institution or planning to attend
- Planning to attend school for the entire academic year (August 2021 - May 2022)
- Current cumulative grade point average of 2.5

Scholarship Application

100 Black Men of Central Illinois Scholarship application is available each year and may be acquired from the chapter, local schools, or our web site www.100bmci.org. The application is a fillable PDF and should be filled out on a computer and printed. If you need an electronic copy, it's available on the web site or you can send an email to info@100bmci.org to request a copy.

Letters of Recommendation

Two typed letters of recommendation, one from a school official and, one from a community member who is not related to the applicant. The recommendations must comment on the following: (1) the personal character and moral reputation of the applicant, (2) the leadership qualities of the applicant with respect to the applicant's previous school experience and the applicant's community involvement.

Acceptance Letter

An acceptance letter from an accredited four-year, two-year educational institution, or graduate school. If an applicant's acceptance letter is not available by the scholarship deadline, please contact a Scholarship Team member, Jeffery Staten at (309) 825-6523 or Raphael Jones at (309) 825-6890. (Note: This letter must be on the official letterhead of the educational institution)

Official Academic Transcript

Applicants must submit an official academic transcript from their most recent school/college or a GED certification.

ESSAY

Applicants are required to submit a typed essay, 600 words minimum, double-spaced, on 8-1/2" x 11" page with 1/2" margin.

The essay topic is as follows:

“How has your family background affected how you see the world?”

Document in detail your views of the world, and how those views have been influenced by your family.”

AWARD NOTIFICATION

The 100 Black Men of Central Illinois, Inc. is once again offering multiple scholarships this year. After receipt of the completed application and the required information, the 100 Black Men of Central Illinois, Inc. may schedule a personal interview with the applicant. All scholarship winners will be notified. Failure to submit all documents required by this application or to follow all directions will disqualify you from consideration.
